



SUFFICIENT PRODUCT AT KPC DEPOTS

Thursday, April 4, 2019 ... Our attention has been drawn to media reports in section of today's press alleging that there is acute shortage of white petroleum products in Nakuru, Nyandarua, Kericho and Bomet areas. The report also attributes the hitch to supply constraints at the KPC depot in Nakuru and nothing could be further from the truth.

To set the record straight, we wish to state as of today April 4, 2019, we had 2.75 million litres of MSP (Super), 3.8 million litres of AGO (Diesel) and 614 thousand litres of IK (Kerosene) at our Nakuru depot. Going by the product statistics of the areas mentioned, the stocks are enough to last the region 4 days for AGO, 2 days for MSP and 3 days of IK.

The alleged supply hitch in the areas mentioned is therefore not caused by insufficient stocks at our Nakuru depot but could be attributed to a delay by resellers of petroleum products in those areas. According to information available to us none of the Oil Marketing Companies has raised concerns about lack of products in our Nakuru Depot.

We thus wish to assure the nation that we have sufficient stocks within our depots to serve both the local and regional markets.
