a) Job Specifications

- i. Improvement of controls by evaluating, redesigning, developing, documenting and implementing of Product Accounting procedures, processes and instruction manual in compliance with the company policy, changing tax regimes and regulations in the Oil Industry.

- iii. Co-ordinate the accounting of all receipts, transfers and deliveries in and out of all Kenya Pipeline installations countrywide.
- iv. Co-ordinate billing of for ex KPC deliveries, side contracts services and any other service offered by KPC.
- v. Compiling monthly performance reports for KPC system including monthly product throughput/ revenue trends, causes and implications.
