a) Job Specifications

- i. Ensure serviceability of Fire vehicles, Mobile firefighting equipment, Fixed fire installations, portable firefighting equipment and all firefighting equipment across all KPC facilities.
- ii. Perform inspection of firefighting equipment, write and submit proposals to modify, replace, and repair fire- fighting equipment.
- iii. Develop and implement fire fighting protocols for KPC depots, based on fire fighting equipment.
- iv. Develop and implement fire emergency evacuation plan within KPC depots
- v. Prepare and submit proposals for repair, modification, or replacement of firefighting equipment
- vi. Undertakes inspection of KPC premises and other hazardous zones to ascertain compliance with safety standards.
- vii. Prepare, coordinate and implement fire training for Emergency Response Training (ERT) members across KPC facilities.
- viii. Provides fire safety awareness to employees and all stakeholders with regards to fire hazards to which they may be exposed.
- ix. Supervise and participate in the inspection of fire fighting equipment in order to ensure that they are in compliance with applicable fire codes, laws, regulations, and standards.
- x. Perform inspection of firefighting equipment, write and submit proposals to modify, replace, and repair equipment.
