a) Job Specification

i. Responsible for the maintenance of KPC Water Treatment Plants to ensure provision of wholesome water for domestic and industrial use in the stations.

iii. Carry out routine and breakdown maintenance of buildings, water supply and reticulation systems in addition to the water treatment plants.
